

Journey to the Cross

- After the Last Supper in the upper room, Jesus prays in the garden of Gethsemane, where he is also arrested. Luke 22:7–30; Matt. 26:36–56
- Jesus stands trial before Annas (location unknown), then the high priest Caiaphas and the Sanhedrin at the house of Caiaphas. John 18:12–13, 19–24; Matt. 26:57–68
- Jesus stands trial before Pilate at Herod's Palace. Luke 23:1–5
- Pilate sends Jesus to Herod Antipas, who sends Jesus back to Pilate. Pilate then sentences Jesus to be crucified. Luke 23:6–12; Matt. 27:11–26
- In the Praetorium, soldiers beat and mock Jesus. He is crucified at Golgotha and his body is placed in a nearby tomb. Mark 15:16–20; John 19:16–42
